



The Cadastre as an implement for Social Cohesion in Latina-America and Europe

A cadastre is first and foremost a regional information system which contains and gives structure to information regarding property ownership. For this information to be used in the design of regional public polity it must be kept up-to-date and adequately disseminated. A proper and effective cadastre is essential to issues such as property rights, the mortgage market and real-estate taxation, town planning, management of government subsidies to housing or the rationalization of rural real-estate.

The European Union and Latin-America have two similar organizations whose objective is to provide a platform for the authorities from the two regions to meet and share their respective experiences. The European organization is the European Cadastre Permanent Committee (www.eurocadastre.org) and the Latin-American organization is the Latin-American Cadastre (www.cadastralatino.org).
